



THE EVELYN BOYER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP STUDENT APPLICATION GUIDELINES

ELIGIBILITY

Applicant must be a graduating high school senior attending college for the first time.
Applicant must have applied to and been accepted by a four-year college or university.
A successful applicant can receive up to \$2500, made payable to the college or university, toward the student's tuition.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Each application must submit an Essay (500 word minimum). The essay should include the following:

- *Long range and short-term goals, plans for educational support (financial, academic, etc.), organizational (writing is confident and clearly focused), vocabulary should reflect a strong beginning, middle and end, with clear transitions, a clear point of view, consistent sentence structure and use of consistent agreement between parts of speech.

- *Statement identifying why applicant should receive the scholarship.

- *Personal Achievements including honors and awards (School, community, church and/or employment).

The applicants must have a personal interview with the Evelyn Boyer Memorial Scholarship Committee, and provide a picture suitable for publication.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION AND REQUIREMENTS

- *Letter of Graduation Substantiation from school official (principal or counselor on institution letterhead).

- *Copy of College Acceptance Letter

- *Official High School Transcript (must have school's official stamp or seal) or Letter of Substantiation (as above).

- *Three Letters of Reference (one each from School Personnel, Community, Church or Employer).

- *List of Memberships and Affiliations, plus Honors and Awards.

APPLICANT'S CHECKLIST AND ENDORSEMENTS

- *Each applicant must complete and attach the Scholarship Application Checklist verifying all components submitted, and agreement to comply with scholarship requirement.

The Story of Evelyn Boyer

Evelyn Boyer was triumphant for the rights of people, especially young people. Her tireless work led to her participation in the civil rights movement. This participation led to her attendance at the 1963 March on Washington and the 1989 Philadelphia, Pennsylvania to Philadelphia, Mississippi Caravan commemorating the Civil Rights struggle. Ms. Boyer's work in Civil Rights caused the NAACP to bestow a Civil Rights honor upon her.

Evelyn Boyer was an avid reader and encouraged young people to read, as well. She was a Certified Reading Coach for the Metropolitan Family of the YWCA's. Her work for children led her to volunteer for Philadelphia Literary Center.

Evelyn Boyer's work with the Young Women's Christian Association (now under the auspices of the Avis Chase Women's Association) led to the current Avis Chase Women's Association to honor Evelyn Boyer and young people with the Evelyn Boyer Memorial Scholarship.
